

*NOTICE OF ALLIANCE OF CAMBRIDGE TENANTS (ACT) JULY BOARD MEETING*

***The Board of the Alliance of Cambridge Tenants is meeting on Tuesday, July 26, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at the ACT Office at Jackson Gardens (located at 135 Prospect Street).***

At the July 26, 2016 board meeting, the ACT Governing Board will vote on amending the ACT Bylaws.

- All ACT members are welcome to attend, however, only current board members are eligible to vote on the proposed bylaws changes.
- If the proposed changes are approved, the board will also vote on amending the ACT FY 2016 Annual Budget to include the anticipated cost of holding a ***board election in October 2016.***
- The main change that is being proposed has to do with the board election process. It would be easier to understand! Eligible voters would be able to cast three votes for candidates from CHA's public housing and/or voucher programs to represent their interests on the ACT board.
- ACT would continue to be the recognized independent tenant organization representing CHA public housing (which includes RAD and Formerly Public Housing developments) and voucher tenants.
- The board would continue to have equal representation from the public housing and voucher programs, though the size of the board would be smaller.
